Jamiat Children Village

After the 2001 Anger earthquake, which claimed 465 schoolchildren's lives, Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind established Jamiat Children Village on 5.25 hectares to house and educate orphans from the earthquake and the 2002 Gujarat pogrom.

Currently, out of **795** students in Jamiat schools **67** are sponsored by JCV.
